- Gather the materials that you want with you when you test
- Practice using the AP Demo
- Review past prompts

2013 Prompt

- Get it out & look at it
- Pause this lesson, read, & annotate it

The Writing Task (Also the Reading Task)

- Analyze how Lawrence employs literary devices to characterize the woman and capture her situation....

Opening Paragraph

- “It was enough for the men...”
- How does this paragraph help the reader understand the woman’s character?

The second paragraph...

- “Her house faced out from the farm-buildings and fields...”
- What do the details about the setting reveal about the woman?

The fourth paragraph

- The Vicar!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
- What does the woman conclude about the vicar and how does this characterize the woman?
